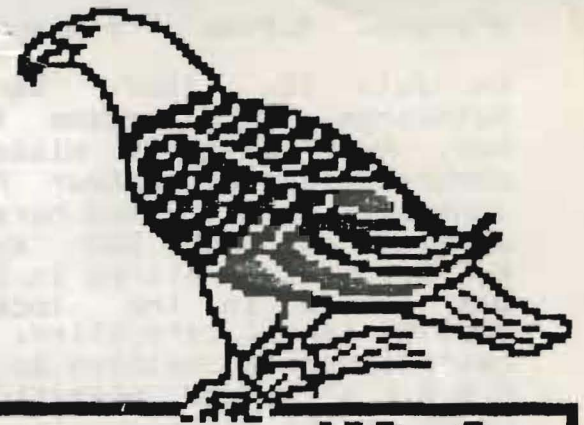

His help, assistance, guidance, and encouragement to all of us is immeasurable. His love of Amateur Radio I am sure is obvious. He was an avid builder and designer, as well as trouble shooter. He was always ready to help in whatever way that he could. His contributions and credits are too numerous to list. He was our Patriarch of Ham Radio. He will be missed by all of us. To his wife Gene, we pass along our deepest heartfelt sympathies. His memory shall be with us.

As you know Rudy was the repeater Trustee for both the 90 and 82 repeaters. Don, W7EGU made a call to the ARRL to see if we could keep Rudy's call on the repeaters in a memorial capacity. However no such regulation exists for allowing us to do this. The change of repeater trustee along with the call on the repeaters will be made as soon as possible. The design configuration of the 82 repeater has to be taken in to consideration. The repeater engineer and assistants are working on this at the moment. A full report on the process and a decision on the trustee will be made at this month's steak fry meeting.

Speaking of the Steak Fry I hope to

see everyone there again this year. The club supplies the steaks and its pot-luck with everything else. We'll be having the usual swap meet as well.
