

OARC WAS RECOGNITION Award Rules



The OARC Worked All States RECONGNITION Award is NOT a hardcopy award certificate. Instead, it is the opportunity to have your name & call sign listed on the OARC awards website.

The purpose of this award is to promote activity (any mode) on all amateur bands (especially during low sunspot activity).

OARC WAS Recognition Award rules:

1. Contact log submissions are not required. HAM Honor System respected. See below.
2. All contacts must be made during Solar Cycle 25 (starting 01 Jan 2020).
3. Station shall make contact with at least one station in each of the 50 US states for the desired band.
4. All Contacts shall be made using any of the following modes: CW, SSB, Any digital mode.
5. CW and QRP endorsements recognized.
6. Recognition Award requests should be sent to OARC eMail address: w7su@arrl.net, topic = "WAS".
 - a. Specify which WAS band (or Any/Mixed band) goal has been achieved.
 - b. If achievement was QRP (low power), please indicate so.
 - c. If achievement was CW mode, please indicate so.
 - d. Specify date of 1st qualifying QSO and date of last qualifying QSO.
7. 10 meter achievements handled separately (see 10m Net WAS Awards).
